**ACTIVE FULL-TIME:** For those faculty or substitutes whose teaching assignment is more than 60% of a normal assignment except for faculty employed as pre-school, Head Start, and child care teachers whose salaries are less than the minimum teacher salary for the district in which they are employed.

**ACTIVE PART-TIME HOURLY:** For those educational employees who teach on a part-time or hourly basis.  
(Category 4)
